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Introduction

In this study you will find in the first part (in colour) some statistics of the FINA Swimming World Championships (25m) held since 1993 and the podiums and number of medals obtained by National Federation.

In the second part (in white for men and in colour for women) appear the standings of the first three places at all events of the FINA World Championships (25m) followed by several classifications which are listed either by the number of titles or medals by swimmer or National Federation.

It should be made clear that these standings only have a historical aim and not any sportive signification because the comparison between the achievements of swimmers of different generations is always unfair for several reasons:

2006. The period of time - The World Championships (25m) were organised every two years between 1993 and 1997 and then successfully in 1999 and 2000 before the adoption of a new biannual cycle: 2002, 2004, etc.

2007. The evolution of the program - The number of events has not stopped growing. To unify the statistics of Olympic and World FINA results, only finalists of relays are mentioned and not those who swam only in qualifications.

This edition may manifest certain errors; we hope that this will be remedied for the next edition with the assistance of our readers.

Vous trouverez dans la première partie (en couleur) de cette étude des statistiques sur les Championnats du Monde de Natation (25m) organisés depuis 1993 ainsi que les podiums et nombres de médailles obtenues par chaque Fédération Nationale.

Dans la seconde partie (en blanc pour les hommes et en couleur pour les femmes) figurent les classements des trois premiers de toutes les épreuves des Championnats du Monde FINA (25 m.) puis plusieurs classifications par nombre de titres ou de médailles par nageur ou nageuse ou par fédération nationale.

Attention, ces classements n'ont qu'un intérêt historique mais n'ont pas de signification sportive car les comparaisons entre les palmarès des nageurs sont toujours injustes en fonction de divers critères :

1. Les époques - Les Championnats du Monde (25 m.) furent disputés tous les deux ans entre 1993 et 1997 puis successivement en 1999 et 2000 avant de reprendre le cycle biannuel 2002, 2004, etc.
2. L'évolution du programme - Le nombre d'épreuves n'a cessé d'augmenter

Afin d'unifier les résultats mondiaux et olympiques de la FINA, seuls les finalistes des relays sont mentionnés; les nageurs n'ayant disputé que les qualifications ne le sont pas.

Cette édition peut comporter quelques erreurs; nous espérons avec l'aide de nos lecteurs y remédier dans l'édition suivante.
