

First Swimming Coaches course of 2015 takes place in Kampala (UGA)

The first FINA Swimming Coaches Certification Course of 2015 will be organised in Kampala, Uganda, from 10 to 12 January. American expert Rick Powers will run the Level 1 course, which will welcome 50 participants coming from Uganda, Sudan and Rwanda. Also part of the FINA development programme for this year, clinics, which train coaches and officials of all levels in five disciplines - swimming, diving, water polo, open water swimming and synchronised swimming - will take place in Congo, Ecuador, Guam, Jordan, Nigeria, Peru and Sri Lanka, to name a few.
