In the proceedings against

the swimmer **Madeline Groves**
affiliated to the Swimming Australia Ltd.

It was decided in Lausanne (Switzerland) on 19th October 2017:

1. Ms Madeline GROVES is found to have committed two whereabouts failures on 18 November 2016 and 6 December 2016.
2. Nevertheless, the whereabouts failure of 26 March 2017 shall not be registered against Ms Madeline GROVES.
3. Consequently, Ms Madeline GROVES did not commit an anti-doping rule violation under FINA DC Rule 2.4 (a combination of three missed tests within a twelve-month period).
4. Each party shall bear its own legal fees and other expenses incurred in connection with the proceedings.
5. Any appeal against this decision may be referred to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), Lausanne, Switzerland not later than twenty one (21) days after receipt of the complete and reasoned judgement (FINA Rule C 12.11.4 and DC 13).
