FINA Doping Panel Decision – Hiromasa Fujimori (JPN)

On 14 December 2018, FINA conducted an in-competition doping control test on the swimmer **Hiromasa Fujimori (JPN)**

on the occasion of the FINA World Swimming Championships held in Hangzhou, China. The athlete was tested positive to the substance Methylephedrine at the extremely low estimated concentration of 16 micrograms/mL (Class S.6 Stimulants).

According to the decision of the FINA Doping Panel, Mr. Hiromasa Fujimori has been found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation under FINA DC Rule 2.1 and he has been sanctioned with a two year (i.e., 24 month) period of ineligibility commencing on 1 January 2019, a date fixed by the Panel pursuant to FINA DC 10.11.1, and ending at the conclusion of 31 December 2020, for his first anti-doping rule violation. All results obtained by Mr. Hiromasa Fujimori on 14 December 2018 were disqualified.
