Eindhoven is a municipality and a city located in the Netherlands. The city has a surface of 88,84 km<sup>2</sup> and a population of 227.000, making it the largest city of the south. Eindhoven is centrally located in Europe and easy accessible via Eindhoven Airport (or three other airports within 1,5 hour drive).
