PR 97- Australia takes four gold in penultimate Diving Grand Prix in Gold Coast

Team Australia was the most decorated nation this weekend in Gold Coast (AUS), as the city hosted the penultimate leg of

the FINA Diving Grand Prix 2018 [1] from November 15-18, 2018.

The home divers stole the gold in the men's 3m springboard with Kevin Chavez (429.45), in the women's 10m platform with Emily Boyd (342.30), in the women's 3m synchro with Georgia Shehan / Esther Qin (263.70) and in the mixed 3m with Anabelle Smith / Domonic Bedgood (280.56).

Team Russia claimed two victories in the men's 10m (Nikita Shleikher, 459.95) and the men's 10m synchro (Aleksandr Belevtsev / Nikita Shleikher, 373.56) respectively.

China, Poland and Germany were the other three nations pocketing gold medals on offer in Gold Coast in the women's springboard (Huang Xiaohui, 306.75), the men's 3m synchro (Andrzej Rzeszutek / Kacper Lesiak, 382.41), and in the mixed 10m (Christina Wassen / Florian Fandler, 284.10) respectively.

In addition, the USA took two silver medals and one bronze; Canada one silver and one bronze; Japan one silver.

The Diving Grand Prix 2018 concludes in Singapore (SGP) on November 23-25.
