The Italian Swimming Federation and the Swimming Club Bolzano Nuoto (Associazione Dilettantistica Bolzano Nuoto) are pleased to invite you to participate at the **23rd FINA Diving Grand Prix** which will be held in **Bolzano** at the Lido di Bolzano from **July 5th to 7th, 2017**.

Enclosed you will find information regarding the Rules of the International FINA Diving Grand Prix series 2015-2017 as well as the Programme and the Provisional Entry Form.

The price for full board and lodging in hotels is Euro 131,00 in single, Euro 105,00 in double, Euro 88,50 in triple room per person per day. Transport from/to Bolzano Airport or Verona Airport (only one transfer for each nation) will be provided for all participants from July 3rd to 8th, 2017.

We kindly ask you to answer by returning the enclosed **Provisional Entry Form** and the **Accommodation Form** by **March 11th, 2017**.

You are kindly asked to make a payment of 50% of the total charge within the terms indicated on the *HOTEL RESERVATION PRELIMINARY BOOKING FORM*, which must be returned by **March 11th, 2017**.

All remaining balance will be due by **May 20th 2017** with **Hotel reservation team Booking Form with Final Entry Form**.

Any cancellations prior to 20th May 2017 will not be penalized. Between 21th May 2017 and 28th May, cancellations will be penalized with a 50% charge of the total cost of the cancelled reservation.

Cancellations from 29th May, will be penalized with a 100% charge of the total cost of the cancelled reservation.

GENERAL RULES

- The competitions will be conducted in accordance to the FINA Rules and Regulations.
- There will be men's and women's individual events:
in 3 meter springboard and 10 meter platform:

Preliminaries, semifinals and finals by Tournament System (dives without limit).

The format for the individual events in the FINA DIVING GRAND PRIX is the tournament system based only on dives with unlimited degree of difficulty (men six dives, women five dives)

The tournament consists of a preliminary competition, two (2) semi-finals with six (6) divers in each and a final with six (6) divers. Semi-final "A" comprises the divers ranked 12-10-8-6-4-2 and Semi-final "B" comprises the divers ranked 11-9-7-5-3-1 in the preliminary competition, however not more than two (2) dives from the Organising Federation may be counted among these twelve (12) divers. In the finals, the three (3) best divers from both semi-finals meet. In the semi-finals and finals, the divers start in the reverse order of their placing in the preliminary competition.

The synchronized events are held as direct finals and are run in accordance with FINA Rule D 3.7. If the Organizing Federation enters two (2) teams, only the best team counts and may go to the podium for the medals.

The Mixed Synchro events are held as direct finals and are run in accordance with FINA Rule D 3.9. If the Organizing Federation enters two (2) teams, only the best team counts and may go to the podium for the medals.

- The maximum number of divers who can participate in an individual DGP event is four (4) from the Host Federation and two (2) from each visiting Federation. The Host Federation may enter four (4) divers in the prelims of an individual event but only two (2) can advance to the semi-finals. The Host Federation may enter two (2) teams in the direct final of a synchro event but only the best team may go to the podium for the medals. No additional divers or teams are allowed to start in a DGP meet, which means that participation in the form of exhibition is not allowed.
- The timetable of the Event could be changed for technical reasons during the Technical Meeting according to the number of athletes entered in each competition and for TV schedules.
- The top 3 places of each Event for both, men and women, will be awarded with medals.
