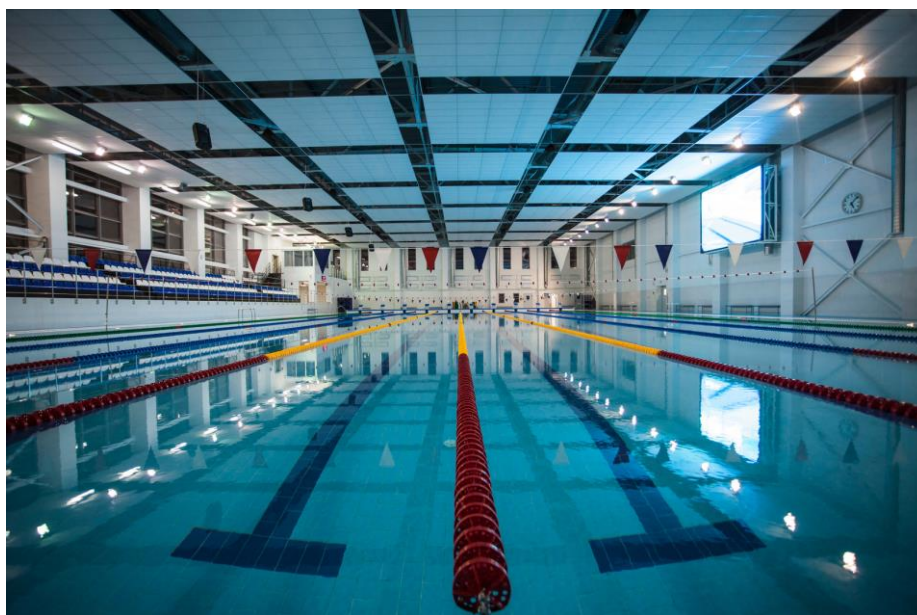

VENUE INFORMATION

- **Main competition venue:**
- 21/2 Universitetskaya Str.Surgut



The competition venue is indoor aquatics center included 50m pools and many premises for different activities as weightlifting, acrobatics and gymnastic rooms. Main competition pool is indoor pool with dimensions of 50 x 25 m. The capacity of tribunes is about 500 spectators. The OC will prepare one more prefabricated tribune for 250 spectators.

Warm up area (only for swimming) is planned to be in the 25m pool (depth 1.10-1.80m) which is in the same complex. Warming up with the balls (20 minutes) will be given to the teams before each game.

- **Training venues:**

Swimming pool 25x25m size, 2.20m depth. The location of the pool is 15 min from the competition venue and team hotels (www.lds-surgut.ru)

ACCREDITATION

To speed up the process of obtaining accreditation for your teams we kindly ask you to send us the signed photos of players and staff who will come in Surgut no later than 10th on August. Please send it in the format jpeg: Country Code_Surname_Name_function (e.x. RUS_Ivanov_Ivan_player).

VISA INFORMATION

For your visa support, please, address our Federation (*in word format by rus_waterpolo@mail.ru*) directly providing application form with the list of participants with every person's passport number, its date of issue and date of expiry, date of birth, place of birth, current citizenship, gender and function position (whether he/she is an official (coach, doctor, team manager, etc.) or a player).

For individual visas we will need copies of the passports, person's occupation, home and office address, telephone and fax numbers and city of obtaining the visa.

For teams from America, Asia and Oceania we also need a Scanned Passport Copy.

To ensure timely visa issuance, please, give us all the necessary information not later than July, 10.

Please note, that the validity of passport must be no less than 6 (six) months before the date of expiry.

Meals: breakfast – 600 rubles, Lunch – 500 rubles, Dinner – 500 rubles
