Introduction

The Italian Swimming Federation has the honor and pleasure to welcome you to the FINA Women's Water Polo Olympic Games Qualification Tournament to be held in Trieste.

The following information has been designed to assist your National Federation in its participation to this event.

Please note that this event will be conducted according to FINA Rules and COVID-19 guidelines and regulations.

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Accreditation and Event Information Desk

Accreditation

The Accreditation will be issued only to those persons who have completed the antigen test with a negative result and have NO signs or symptoms of COVID-19 infection. Accreditation will be delivered at the hotel at the "Event Information Desk", both at Hotel NH Trieste and DoubleTree by Hilton.

EVENT INFORMATION DESK

In both NH Hotel and DoubleTree by Hilton, there will be an information desk, placed in the main hall, where staff members will provide information regarding transports, departures' pick-up times and will help delegates and teams with any issue that occurs. Moreover, the staff will provide accreditation cards. At the NH Hotel, at the information desk, teams will be able to book the meeting room, find the right breakfast, lunch, and dinner time.

Teams are kindly asked to follow as much as possible, both transport times and mealtimes, to allow staff to sanitize all ambients and respect all COVID measures. Bottles of water will be provided to all participants at their hotels. For any other request please ask the information desk as due to COVID measures, it's not permitted to go outside the hotel, except for training and matches.

Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will take place on 18th January in the afternoon, at 17:00pm - Meeting room at the swimming pool.

The technical meeting will be conducted in a meeting room large enough to ensure physical distancing.

Only essential people should attend. All Participants must wear face masks.

The CMC of each team should ensure that the team is fully aware of the COVID-19 procedures for warm-up, entrance to the competition pool area, during the breaks and match end.

Final team list must be determined according to the test results.

Anti-Doping Procedures

A clean (disinfected) doping control room will be made available for the anti-doping procedures in the swimming pool. The room will be large enough to allow players and anti-doping staff to be able to be physically distanced. Everyone in the room must wear a face mask and gloves.

TRANSPORTATION

The organizing committee will welcome all members of the participating National Federations at Trieste and Venice Airport.

The OC will be providing transportation services between the airport, the official team hotels, and the competition venue as per FINA COVID-19 Guidelines and Regulations; so, upon arrival, and also for departures, during all transportation, all must wear a face mask.

Transportation schedules for training days are here attached at the end of this document. Transportation schedule for match days will be provided upon arrival.

Before Arrivals

Concerning the FINA Covid-19 Guidelines (see 4.2 COVID-19 - Testing Procedure) sent by FINA Waterpolo on December 21st, to avoid any possible misunderstanding we would like to point out as follows.

As stated only the Participants (athletes, athlete's entourage, media, technical partners, e.g. timing and scoring staff and FINA Family, referees, judges, FINA Staff, Technical Committee Member or Bureau members) with evidence of a recent negative COVID-19 PCR test and a recent negative Ag test will be eligible to attend the Women's Water Polo Olympic Games Qualification Tournament. All costs related to the above-mentioned tests are to be borne by the participant and/or their Federations.

Therefore all Participants (listed above) must follow the protocol hereunder:

1. Send to waterpolo@fina.org a (negative) **PCR-test** not older than 72 hours.
2. Send to the Organising Committee of the event (international@federnuoto.it) the negative result of a **PCR** or **AntiGen test** which is not older than 48 hours from the arrival in Italy, as currently requested by the Italian Authority to enter to Italian Territory.

N.B. In case you are able to do a PCR test not older than 48h, this could be valid for both the requests at points 1 and 2, so you can send it to waterpolo@fina.org and international@federnuoto.it.

Participants are requested to bring a copy of the test with them and to show it at police control upon arrival on the Italian Territory otherwise they need to quarantine, therefore they will be not able to attend/participate in the event.

Arrivals

The organizing committee will facilitate airport welcome and transportation services to all those who have put the arrivals and departures information on FINA GMS.

Procedures Upon arrival

All Participants will be tested upon their arrival. Teams and delegates will be transported to the relative hotels, where the first Antigen Test and PCR Test will be implemented. The team must wait for the result of the Antigen Test, and then can leave this place. Upon arrival, during transportation, and during testing, all must wear a face mask.

After receiving the negative antigen test result delegates will be allowed to go through the check-in procedures at the hotel and train. Delegates must have a negative result and NO signs or symptoms of COVID-19 infection.

Upon receiving also, the PCR Test result, Team can compete in the tournament.

In order to facilitate the check-in procedure, Team leaders are kindly asked to collect all team's passports to show them at the reception.

Training and Competition

During the training and competition period transport (bus service) between the main pool, the training pools and the official hotels will be organized for this event. It's mandatory to take the bus with the own Team and not with another Team and the right time that will be indicated in the TRANSPORT SCHEDULING.

Departures

If you have provided your travel details, the event information desk at the hotel will publish your departure details the day before departure.

COVID-19 Rules and Regulations will be applied.

Any test that may be requested to a foreign participant when she/he returns to her/his living country will be at her/his own costs. The cost of a PCR is 60 Euros to be paid directly to the testing authority.

Please notify to the OC staff the names of the people who needs to take the test before departure. We will put Teams and delegates in contact with local medical authorities in order to schedule tests.

EVENT INFORMATION PACKAGE for COVID-19

Hygiene Measures

Every accredited person must follow basic principles shown below. These are valid for travel to competition, at the hotel, and at the training/competition venue.

Please note:



Wash your hands thoroughly



Cough and sneeze into a tissue
or the crook of your arm



Wear a mask



Avoid shaking hands,
hugging, kissing



Stay at home if you have
symptoms



Keep your 1.5m distance

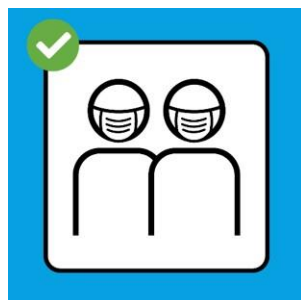
Items/equipment/tools should NOT be shared. If this cannot be avoided, the user must disinfect his/her hands and the specific item before and after use.

Hand sanitizers points will be available at all official venues, transportation hubs, and official hotels.

Rooms in all official locations must be well ventilated.

Athletes must use personal water bottles, refilled from no-touch water-outlets. Water bottles must not be shared.

Masks / Face-Nose Protection



Every accredited person MUST wear a mask / mouth-face nose protection at all times in official event locations including:

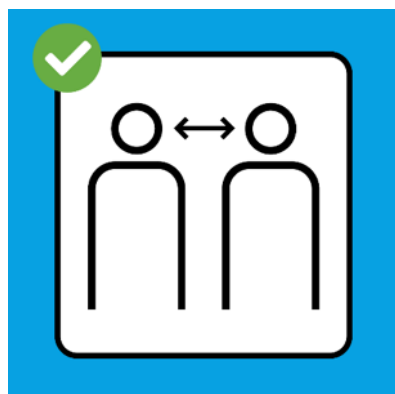
- Main Venue
- On official transportation
- At official hotels except when eating.

General exceptions to wearing a mask / mouth-face nose protection are outlined in sport-specific appendices.

When not worn the mask must be kept in a separate container/bag (e.g. sandwich "Ziploc" bag) to prevent contamination. Disposable masks must be regularly changed and multi-use masks washed after regular use.

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Physical Distancing



The physical distance of 1.5 meter minimum must be respected at all times (except when training and during competition).

All participants must follow the Signage that will indicate safe physical distancing at points of entry, or floor markings to show flow of traffic to respect physical distancing.

App Immuni

A Tracing-App is available within Italy. This App is easy to use, no personal data will be asked, only the region in which the event is taking place, Friuli Venezia Giulia, and the City, Trieste. IMMUNI can be easily downloaded from every event participants.

COVID-19 Measures

COVID-19 Officer

This Officer is the focal point for all COVID-19 related matters for team delegations and those with FINA accreditation. All referrals for medical advice, testing, and management of symptomatic individuals can only be made through the OC COVID-19 Officer.

All COVID-19 measures will be applied as per FINA COVID Guidelines and Italian regulations. Each evaluation has been done and will be done according to local authorities.

We remind that Italian law imposes as maximum body temperature for entering venues as 37.5 °C.

In the middle of the tournament will be done at least a second antigen test to all participants, as per FINA COVID Guidelines. The exact date will be provided after a consultation with local authorities, depending also on the epidemiological situation and potential local authorities' request.

DECLARATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

I _____ declare,

1. That I have full knowledge and awareness that the practice of the sport of Water Polo both in trainings and in competitions implies a risk of infection of COVID-19 and which I am aware of and accept.
2. That I do not present symptoms of the SARS-CoV-2 Coronavirus (fever greater than or equal to 38.0 degrees, cough, general malaise, feeling of shortness of breath, loss of taste, headache, fatigue, neck pain, muscle pain, vomiting, diarrhea) or any other typical symptoms of the infections.
3. That I have not been tested positive or had close contact with any person(s) with possible or confirmed symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days prior to the date of signing this document.
4. That I have read the safety protocols, the information of hygiene prevention and the safety measures of COVID-19 established by the organizer of the Event and I agree to comply with them in all manners.
5. That I am responsible for my behavior according to the Guidelines during the entire Event including the preparation period and the travel to the Event.
6. That I am aware of and accept that non-compliance with the rules of COVID-19 (especially the non declaration of having tested positive or not having declared the fact of having had a close relationship with people with symptoms) implies a very serious infraction of the disciplinary code that can lead to a sanction of exclusion from the competition and the loss of the sports license for a period to be decided by FINA.
7. That I promise to inform the Organizer and the respective FINA official(s) or the delegation's COVID19 Medical Coordinator (CMC) about any symptoms that are compatible with COVID-19 or about the fact of having tested positive or the existence of any presumed or confirmed case of COVID-19 in the family or close environment and I promise to keep the CMC promptly informed about their evolution. This information will be treated confidentially and for the sole purpose of being able to adopt the necessary measures to prevent the contagion and spread of the virus.
8. That I am aware of and accept that the organizer of the Event has registered all the participants in order to be able to have traceability in case of a positive test result or positive symptoms among any of the participants or team(s) who have had close contact close during the Event.

By completing this document, the signature grants the consent for FINA/Organizer to process with all data only with strict medical and preventive point of view. At the same time, and by signing this document, I declare to know the specific protection and hygiene measures established in the Protocol of the Event.

To be in compliance with the aforementioned rules is an individual responsibility of each of the participants and of the Federation or entity that organizes the Event, without there being any responsibility on the part of FINA in case of infection(s) that occurs in relation with the Event.

If any member of the OC or any other Participant fails to comply with any of the requirements set out in the FINA COVID-19 Guidelines, their accreditation card may be removed by the OC COVID-19 Officer, following consultation with FINA and they will be required to leave the venue immediately.

In addition, violations of these Guidelines might be subject to disciplinary proceedings and sanctions pursuant to FINA Rules.
